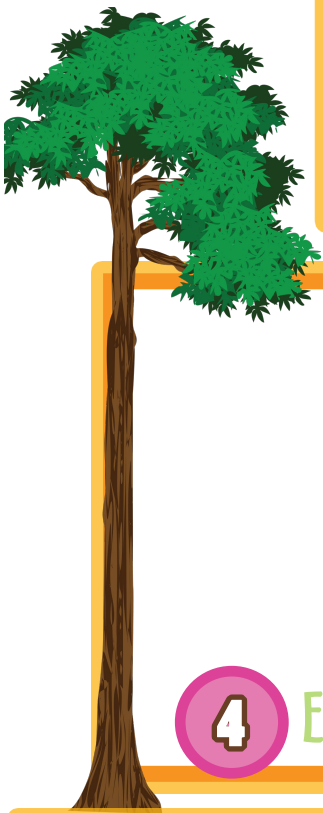

LEAF ART

Place a leaf under the paper and colour where the leaf is with a crayon or a pencil.

You need to press fairly hard to create a good outline of the leaf.

You can fill the whole frame with leaves!



Flying Parrot — Page 1

Instructions:

1. Write your name on the back of the parrot.
2. Cut out the body, wing pieces and tail feathers.
3. To make the wing:
 - Glue the blue feathers to the back of the yellow feathers.
 - Glue the yellow feathers to the back of the red feathers.
 - Fold the blue and yellow feathers at the tabs to create a 3-D ruffled effect for the wing.
4. Fold the red tab back and glue it to the body near the neck. If you attach it straight, the wing will be by the parrot's side. If you attach it at an angle, it will look like the parrot is in flight.
5. If you want, glue a googly eye over the parrot's eye.
6. Turn the parrot over and tape the tail feathers to the back, first the short one then the long one.
7. Tape a piece of string to the back of the head so you can hang your parrot.
8. Have fun flying your parrot!

Instructions:

1. Write your name on the back.
2. Cut along the dotted lines of the background.
3. Fold in on the three lines.
4. Spread glue on the tab that says "Spread glue here".
5. Place the tab under the forest floor and press together to attach them.
6. Stand the scene up.
7. Cut out the plants, animals and verse.
8. Fold the tabs on the plants and attach them to the forest floor. Put the yellow plant toward the back.
9. Fold the tabs on the verse and glue them to the outside (on each side and under the bottom).
10. Spread a little glue at each side on the back of the sloth and attach it to the background, stretching across from one wall to the other.

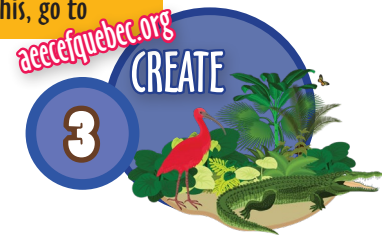

Materials:

Markers or crayons
Scissors
Glue stick
Hole punch (optional)
Pencil (for poking holes)
Paper fastener

Instructions:

1. Write your name.
2. Choose a wheel and colour the frogs or butterflies.
3. Cut out the wheel and the leaves. Cut out the stand along the dotted lines.
4. Fold the stand in half at the top of the leaf background.
5. Use a pencil to poke holes in the green dots in the center of the wheels and on the front of the stand.
6. Cut along the green dotted line on the front.
7. Place a paper fastener through the holes to attach the wheel behind the leaf background.
8. Put a small piece of tape to close the opening of the slit you cut in the stand. Make sure that the wheel turns freely.
9. Glue the leaves along the dotted line so that they hang a little bit over the edge and cover where the wheel will turn. This will create a more realistic leafy effect.
10. Fold the tabs of the stand back.
11. Glue the small tab to the back tab.
12. Stand your creation up, turn the wheel and watch your colourful frogs or butterflies move through the rainforest!

Instructions:

1. Cut out the green banner.
2. Write your name on the back.
3. Cut out the leaves. Make sure to leave the tabs attached.
4. Fold the tabs forward.
5. Spread glue on the back of each tab and, starting at the bottom of the banner, glue each tab just above an animal or a group of words so that the leaf hides the animal or words. Don't cover the logo or the frog.
When all the leaves are attached you will have a rainforest of hidden surprises!
6. Punch holes at the two small leaves at the top of the banner, then thread a piece of yarn or string through the holes and tie a knot. (If you don't have a hole punch, you can tape the string to the back of the banner at the top.)
7. Hang your banner in your room. When you lift a leaf you will reveal a rainforest animal God created or a truth about God that you can believe! Show it to a friend and let them discover the hidden surprises of your rainforest!

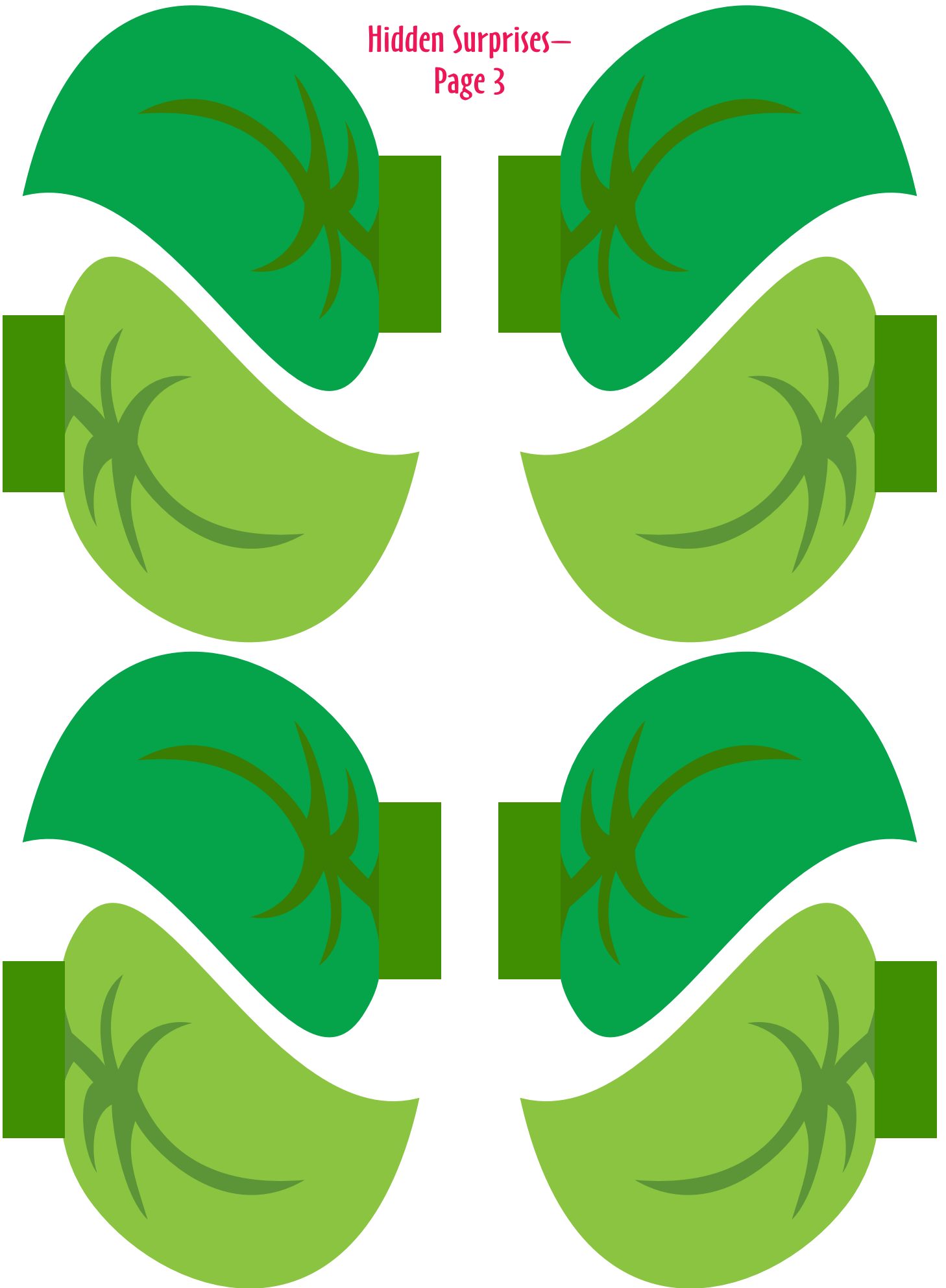
