

Flying Parrot — Page 1

Instructions:

1. Write your name on the back of the parrot.
2. Cut out the body, wing pieces and tail feathers.
3. To make the wing:
 - Glue the blue feathers to the back of the yellow feathers.
 - Glue the yellow feathers to the back of the red feathers.
 - Fold the blue and yellow feathers at the tabs to create a 3-D ruffled effect for the wing.
4. Fold the red tab back and glue it to the body near the neck. If you attach it straight, the wing will be by the parrot's side. If you attach it at an angle, it will look like the parrot is in flight.
5. If you want, glue a googly eye over the parrot's eye.
6. Turn the parrot over and tape the tail feathers to the back, first the short one then the long one.
7. Tape a piece of string to the back of the head so you can hang your parrot.
8. Have fun flying your parrot!

Materials:

Scissors
Glue stick
Tape
Googly eye (optional)
String

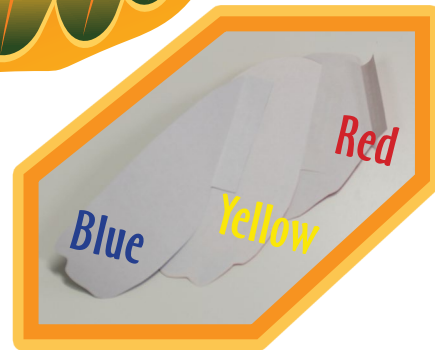
