How to clearly present the Gospel to children

The course we were waiting for!

The "Progressive Methods of Child Evangelism" module of Children's Ministries Institute® looks at different ways to present the unchanging truths of the Gospel to children. For several years, French-speaking CEF workers from the North America / Caribbean Region have planned to take this course. Unfortunately we've encountered one obstacle after another. Finally, in April of this year, our workers were able to benefit from this online training given by different CEF instructors,

including our provincial directors, Jenne and Mary. We were happy to take the course with our classmates from several countries. The final count was 20 students from Haiti, three from Guadeloupe, two from Martinique, two from French Guyana and six from Quebec.

The course enabled us to deepen our knowledge of what Scripture says about teaching and evangelizing children, and to acquire new teaching methods adapted to this generation of children. All of the students came away with a deeper understanding of the biblical basis for child evangelism, a wonder at God's love for children and their importance to Him, and a renewed commitment to reaching children.



Let's share the Gospel of Jesus with children!



Although Adam and Eve sinned and were forced to leave the Garden of Eden, God granted them the joy of bearing children. I'm sure Adam and Eve were amazed at the birth of their first two sons, Cain and Abel. They must have cherished them as they watched them grow! However, sin came to spoil their joy. Looking back on the summer: three different themes!

Although we organized and taught *Party Clubs* last summer, this summer was the first time since the return of in-person activities that we taught *5-Day Clubs*, our week-long summer programs. The theme of our clubs was "Dive! Exploring God's Grace". We also had some great *Party Clubs* with a "Secret of the Watermelon" theme and we organized a day camp in Montreal with the theme "In the Land of the Dinosaurs". This was quite unusual, as we generally concentrate on one theme for the whole summer. Next year, we'd like to go back to just one!





As part of the "Progressive Methods of Child Evangelism" course, we had to present Party Clubs to put into practice what we learned. Approximately 100 French-speaking and English-speaking children were able to participate and clearly heard the message of salvation through the colours of the watermelon!

Our ministry this summer began at a camp where we taught more than a hundred children. Despite the large number of children, they were attentive and participated well in the various activities. Throughout the week, they were able to "dive" into the marine world to discover some of the things created by our great God. But above all, they were able to explore the wonderful grace of God. After the week spent at camp, we organized and taught eight 5-Day Clubs using the same theme. Our entire team was surprised to see the level of energy needed for a full week of ministry! But it was a joy for us to see hundreds of energetic and enthusiastic children participating in these clubs!









God, the Creator of everything!

For the last week of summer, we ran a day camp with the theme "In the Land of the Dinosaurs: God the Creator of Everything!" The children who participated had a lot of fun and learned all sorts of things about dinosaurs. More importantly, through the Bible lessons, the verse teaching, the missionary story, and the object lessons, the children were able to learn how sin entered the perfect world God had created and how, in His love, God sent His Son Jesus to save them.



The final count for our summer ministry: over 400 children participated in an outreach activity and we had the joy of seeing 20 children receive Jesus as Saviour! The CEF workers, along with several of our wonderful, experienced volunteers, coordinated our efforts to accomplish this important work!
